The Board of Elders met on Tuesday April 11, 2023.

- Administrative items were reviewing Pastor Pett's report and worship attendance reports.
- Ten members have agreed to accept the position of Communion Assistant. After receiving training in mid April they will begin assisting Pastor Pett and an elder with Communion during our worship services.
- Letters and questionnaires have been sent to non-attending members. Pastor Pett shared some of the responses from those who had received the letters. Several letters came back as undeliverable. The responses from non-attending members will continue to be monitored.
