- Sound Dampening Panels for the gym— still need an estimate
- New Cushions for the former stage wall are here and need to be installed.

Financial Report — Randy Pfister reported that March Total Offerings were \$30,200 (Note: Does not include 3/31 Easter), and Total Income came in at \$34,400. Our Expenses were at \$37,000. Year To Date — Income is at \$273,300, with Offerings up 3.8% over last year. Expenses were at \$274,900
